### CONSTITUTION.

Proposed NAME of the GROUP.:

The name of the Society shall be "GUJARATI SAMAJ NEW ZEALAND Incorporated"

Hereafter referred to as 'The Society".

2. REGISTERED OFFICE:

The registered office of the Gujarati Samaj New Zealand will be care of:

### AIMS AND OBJECTIVES .:

- To preserve, promote and support Gujarati Language Heritage and cultural values.
- To assist & empower the women and youth by providing them with the opportunities to be involved in the decision making process of the society.
- To promote the culture and traditions in members by celebrating their festivals and cultural programs with a view of promoting cross cultural understanding with other communities of New Zealand.
- To unite and organise Gujarati residing in New Zealand to increase cultural awareness and communication skill by lectures, workshop, debates and seminars.
- To keep the community aware of the issues affecting the lives of the young people. 3.5
- 3.6 To Promote friendship, fellowship, mutual understanding and organise activities for the socialization, getting together feeling freedom and happiness amongst members.
- To share and enhance the experiences of different ethnic groups for the benefits of the community.
- To encourage and assist the Gujarati students, migrants coming to New Zealand, the understanding of New Zealand's culture, legal, economic and social system.
- To seek accept & receive donations, subsidies, grants, endorsements, gifts, Legacies, loans, any banquets either in money or other Property for all or any of the purposes & objects of the society.
- 3.10 Generally all such activities and acts as are deemed proper and in the best interest of the members.

### Membership.

### 4.1 Criteria:

I). any person, He/ She who belong to a Gujarati descent can be a member of the Gujarati Samaj, New Zealand.

II). He/ She must be a New Zealand citizen / PR.

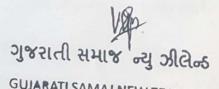

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- 4.3 Approval: An applicant must sign DECLARATION Form annexed to the application for membership prescribed by the society. He/ She shall be eligible for membership upon approval of the application by the Executive committee. The Executive committee in its absolute discretion may refuse any application without having to give any reasons for refusal of membership.
- **4.4 Subscription:** The subscription payable by such members is an annual amount of \$11.00 and the membership will end on the 31<sup>st</sup> March of every year. Provided the member shall be allowed to pay the subscription by the 31<sup>st</sup> March and in the event of default in payments by the said 31<sup>st</sup> March His/ Her name will be removed from the membership record. The subscription amount will be subject to review by the Executive committee as need arise.
- 4.5 Membership Registry: Upon an application for membership being approved and the required subscription having been paid his / her name shall be entered in the membership register kept by the Society and this entry in the register shall be conclusive final evidence of the membership.
- 4.6 Voting Right: A member of the society who has completed one year of membership is only eligible to vote.
- 4.7 Liability of members: The membership of the Society shall not confer on any member or person the interest or share in the funds and property of the Society nor be personally liable to the Society.
- 4.8 Undertaking of the members: Each member of the Society undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Society and be sincere, faithful, & responsible for the progress & fulfilment of the aims & objectives.
- 4.9 Disciplinary Action: Any member whose conduct is found to be detrimental to the interests of the Society or in breach of terms of the constitution of the Society may be liable to the disciplinary action by the Executive committee. The Member may be :-
  - (a). Reprimanded or admonished.
  - (b). Suspended from an office or membership indefinitely or for a specified period. Also:-
  - (i) Any member facing disciplinary action may be immediately suspended from the membership or an office of the Society by the Executive committee until the matter is determined.
- (ii) The member subject to a disciplinary action may be given an opportunity to provide a detailed written submission to answer the Complaint as to his /her conduct within 7 days of a notice.
- Income and property: All properties, assets, (fixed real or otherwise) and CAPITAL FUNDS shall be vested and held by the Executive Management committee of the Society and be applied solely towards the promotion of the objectives of the Society; and no portion of the same shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise however by way of profit to the members of the Society. Provided that no members of the Society shall be appointed to any salaried office of the Society, paid any fees, and that no remuneration shall be given by the Society to any member of the Society except payment of out of pocket expenses and interest on money lent or rent for premises let to the Society.
- 6 Executive Committee: The Executive Committee shall be constituted of the Office Bearers being A President, A vice President, A Secretary, A Joint Secretary, A treasurer, and 6 members.



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- 6.1 Election of the Executive committee: The Executive committee shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting or an Extraordinary General Meeting of the Society convened for the purpose in accordance with the provision herein prescribed. The Executive committee members election shall be held at every TWO (2) Years and the new committee shall elect

- II). any member cannot be an Executive Member of the society unless He /She has directly migrated to New Zealand from Gujarati Family, India.
  - 6.2 Nomination and Election: The PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATION OF THE CANDIDATES FOR **ELECTION OF Executive Committee shall be as follows:** 
    - a. All the nominations shall be in writing on the prescribed form issued by the Society.
    - b. Every candidate shall be nominated by an approved and subscribed member and seconded by another such member. The candidate must consent to the nomination and sign an undertaking to serve in the position diligently and with dedication.
    - c. Nomination form properly completed in all respects must reach to the Authorized Officer appointed by the Executive Committee Seven Days (7 Days) prior to the date of the meeting or a date fixed by the Executive committee by post or personnel delivery.
  - d. The Authorized Officer shall examine all nominations, if the same are properly completed and are in order in all respect and present all valid nominations for election in the meeting. Provided the Authorized Officer may decline all nominations that are not properly completed and the candidates are not qualified.
  - e. All nominations approved by the Authorized Officer shall be presented for election in the meeting by secret ballot unless the chairman with the consent of the meeting shall decide otherwise.
  - 6.3 Management of Affairs: The affairs of the Society shall be managed by the Executive Committee who may exercise all such powers of the Society as are not by this constitution or rules required to be exercised by the Society in the general meeting shall invalidate any prior act of the Executive committee which would have been valid if that resolution has not been made.
- 6.4 Retirement or Resignation: Any Office Bearer, Executive member of the Society may at any time retire or resign from the Society by giving notice in writing of his / her intention to do so to the Secretary or the President.
  - 6.5 Filling of the vacancy: The Executive Committee may fill any vacancy arising from vacation resignation, death, expulsion, or otherwise for unexpired term. Unless the Executive Committee decides to act and continue with its function or operation in the absence of any member or official.
- 6.6 Quorum: In all Executive meeting 7 (Seven) members shall constitute to form the Quorum.
- 6.7 Decision by Majority vote: All matters before a meeting of the Executive Committee, General Meeting or an extra ordinary Meeting shall be decided by a majority votes. In case of a tie or equal division, the chairperson shall have a casting vote.

7.0 Meeting and its conduct:

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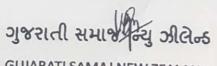
- **7.1 General Meeting**: There shall be an Annual General Meeting of the Society, at a place and time as the President in consultation with the Executive Committee decides. The Executive Committee may decide to delay the annual general Meeting for some justifiable reason.
- 7.2 Extra ordinary General Meeting; An extra ordinary general meeting of the society may be convened either by the executive committee or by requisition signed by not less than 2/3 majority of members of the society. The time & place of such meeting shall be determined by the executive committee. Provided such a meeting shall only be convened in the event of there being in the absolute discretion of the executive committee, a genuine special business required to be dealt with or addressed in such a meeting.
- **7.3 Right to vote:** Each subscribed & approved members shall have a single vote in all meetings of the society except the president who shall have a casting vote in case of a tie. Provided any new member or members approved after the date of the general meeting or extraordinary general meeting being fixed or set up and declared shall not be eligible to vote at such a meeting.
- **7.4 Chairperson:** The president of the society and in his absence, a vice president shall preside at every general meeting or committee meetings of the society. In the absence of the both, the members present shall elect any member present to be the chairperson.
- **7.5 Meeting notice and quorum:** Twenty one (21) days notice shall be given of any annual general or extraordinary general meeting and 2/3 rd of the members on the membership register of the society shall constitute a quorum thereat.
- **7.6 Adjournment of the meetings:** The chairperson may, with the consent of the executive committee adjourn any meeting, from place to place or in the event of the chairperson having reason to believe that the meeting can become uncontrolled, he/she may adjourn the meeting at his /her desecration to another date and place.

#### 7.7 Notice of motion:

- (a) At least Fourteen (14) days notice in writing shall be given to the secretary of any motion or resolution to be presented or discussed at an annual general meeting or extraordinary general meeting.
- (b) At least seven (7) days notice shall be given to the secretary of the society of any motion or resolution to be presented or discussed in an executive meeting.

### 7.8 Executive committee meetings:

- (a) The secretary shall call the meeting of the executive committee at least every month, or earlier at such a place and day as may be decided with consultation or approval of the president or vice president.
  - (b) At least three (3) days notice shall be given of any executive meeting. Provided any urgent meeting may be called by notice of such shorter period as may be deemed advisable.
  - **8.0** Operations: To facilitate better management and operation of the affairs of the society, the executive committee shall consist of eleven (11) committee members of which five (5) will be office bearers and six (6) elected committee members.
  - **8.1 Accounts:** True accounts shall be kept of the sums of the money received and expended by the society, and the matter in respect of which such receipts and expenditure takes place and of the property, credits and liabilities of the society and subjects to any reasonable restrictions as



to the time and the manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the decision of the society.

- **8.2** Examination of the Accounts: Once at least every year, the accounts of the society shall be examined and the balance sheet be prepared by a qualified external Account.
- **8.3 Reserve Funds:** Any funds that has been collected, set aside, donated or accrued for any specific purpose shall be reserved, earmarked or put in a society fund **Account** for such specific purpose and used for that purpose only.
- **8.4 Operation of accounts.** All the money, deposits, accounts and other securities shall stand in the name of the society. Treasurer will be one signatory and other signatory will be either secretary or any appointed person of the executive committee jointly shall withdraw money draw interest on such securities or sign check in Accordance with the resolution passed by the executive committee.
- **8.5 Financial reports:** The accounts of the society shall be prepared annually by an independent qualified accountant and the copy of the balance sheet shall be laid before the annual general meeting or an extraordinary general meeting convened for the purpose, discussed and proved.
- **8.6 Common Seal:** The common seal of the society shall be of such make and design as decided by the executive committee.
- **8.7 Execution of Documents:** The common seal of the society shall be affixed to all deeds and documents executed on behalf of the society in the presence of or by the secretary, the president and the treasurer or such officers as may be dominated by the executive committee from time to time.
- **8.8 Services of notices:** Any notice required to be served by the society on the members shall be held sufficient if posted to him /her on the address recorded in the **membership** register of the society. Provided any meeting notice advertised in the local television, radio or other news media shall constitute a proper service.
- 8.9 Annual Report: An annual report of the activities of the society shall be presented to the annual general meeting.
- 8.10 Close of Financial Year: The financial year of the society shall close or end on 31st March.

### 8.11 Position Description:

- (a) President: The president shall apart from all other usual duties herein be in constant consultation of the affairs of the society with the executive body of the society.
- (b) Vice President: The vice president shall apart from usual duties allocated herein attend to any duties or portfolio allocated by the executive committee or shall work in absence of president.
- (c) Secretary: The secretary shall keep the records of the minutes of the proceedings of the society to be signed by the president or the chair person of the meeting and all other records and shall be general administrator of the affairs of the society falling into his/her portfolio in terms of the directions of the executive Committee.

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- he decision
- (d) Joint Secretary: The joint secretary shall apart from usual duties allocated herein attend to any duties or portfolio allocated by the executive committee. And also will attend to the duties of the secretary in absence the secretary.
- (e) Treasurer: The treasurer shall keep accounts of the receipts and disbursement and the register of the members. The treasurer shall be responsible to collect all funds, dues and donations. Contributions and subscriptions from the members and others and deposit such collections in bank account or accounts in the name of the society. The treasurer shall be the financial controller of the society and present the statement of accounts to the executive committee from time to time, preparation of the annual financial statements and presentation thereof.
- (f) Subcommittees: There will be subcommittees required from time to time to cater the need arising from various projects and activities. There will be a chairperson of each subcommittee.
- **9.0 Winding Up:** If upon winding up or dissolution of the society, there remains after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid or distributed amongst the members of the society but if and so far as effect can given to the next provision, shall be given or transferred to another organisation that is charitable under New Zealand law or for sum other charitable purpose recognised under the New Zealand law to be determined by the members of the society at or before the time of the dissolution and in default thereof by such judge of the supreme court or other appropriate court of justice as may have or acquired jurisdiction in the matter.
- 10. Alteration/Additions or rescission of the constitution: The general meeting or the extra ordinary general meeting of the society by special resolution / motion approved by 2/3 of the members present in the meeting alter, add, revise, rescind or amend this constitution. Provided in any event the paragraph 8 hereof shall be altered, added to, revised, amended or rescinded.

#### 11. General:

- (a) The executive committee must act diligently prudently and within the terms of the entity rules and are accountable for the respective actions.
- (b) A monthly meetings of the members shall be held to discuss and plan the activities of the society and recommend the decisions to the executive whose decision shall be final.
- 12. Interpretation: In this constitution:-

"ACT "means...." THE INCORPORTED SOCIETY'S ACT 1908"
